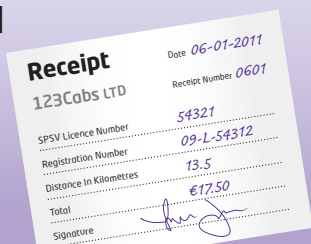


Useful information for hackney passengers

- A receipt on payment of fare.



You are obliged to

- Pay the fare agreed.
- Behave in a civil and orderly fashion.
- Not damage the vehicle or its contents.

Recognising a licensed driver

- A **Tamper Proof Licence Disc** is displayed on the front and rear windows. It specifies:
 - ▶ **Vehicle licence number**
 - ▶ **Vehicle registration number**
 - ▶ **Passenger number vehicle is licensed to carry**
 - ▶ **Vehicle licence expiry date**
- The **Driver ID Card** is displayed on the dashboard. It specifies:
 - ▶ **Driver name**
 - ▶ **Driver licence number**
 - ▶ **Driver licence expiry date**



Purple and yellow **Driver ID Cards** are in operation.

Recovering lost property

- As you booked your cab through a hackney operator, contact them first.
- An Garda Síochána is responsible for lost property handed in by hackney operators.
- Provide the Gardaí with the licence number of the hackney (shown on your receipt).
- Property handed in is retained for 31 days to enable you to reclaim it.
- The Gardaí will ask for proof of identity before handing over property.
